## **Taunsa Sharif تہسنوت:**

Taunsa is a Tehsil (subdivision) of Dera Ghazi Khan in the Punjab Province of Pakistan. The town of Taunsa sharif is the headquarters of the tehsil. The town contains important Sufi Shrines, the most notable of which is that of Pir Khwajah Shah Sulaiman taunswi (Chishti), popularly known as Pir Pathan, Saraiki is the local language, while Urdu and English are official languages used in various educational and government institutions.

Taunsa Sharif is located on the Karachi-Peshawar highway which is also known as Indus high way, it is approximately 975 Km from karachi and 600 Km from Lahore. It is located at 30°41'N 70°39'0E lying west of the Indus River with an altitude of 157 metres (518) Taunsa is also the location of one of the notable structures on the Indus called Tuansa Barrage, located several kilometres south of Taunsa City.

Flood of the August 2010 has destroyed almost whole villages of Taunsa Shareef which includes; UC Naarhi, Sokar Hairo, Bhet Ladha, More Jhangi, Kot Qaisrani, Shelani, These villages have washed away by flood, Animals have drowned and grain storages have washed away, Hill Torres has also destroyed the villages include Kohar, Tibi Qaisrani Jhok Bhodho and other tribal areas

An emergency was declared in Dera Ghazi Khan, as it could be affected when inflows of up to 900,000 cusecs cross the Taunsa barrage during August 1 to 3<sup>rd</sup>.

And later on Flood destroyed thousands of Houses and took like of precious Animals.
